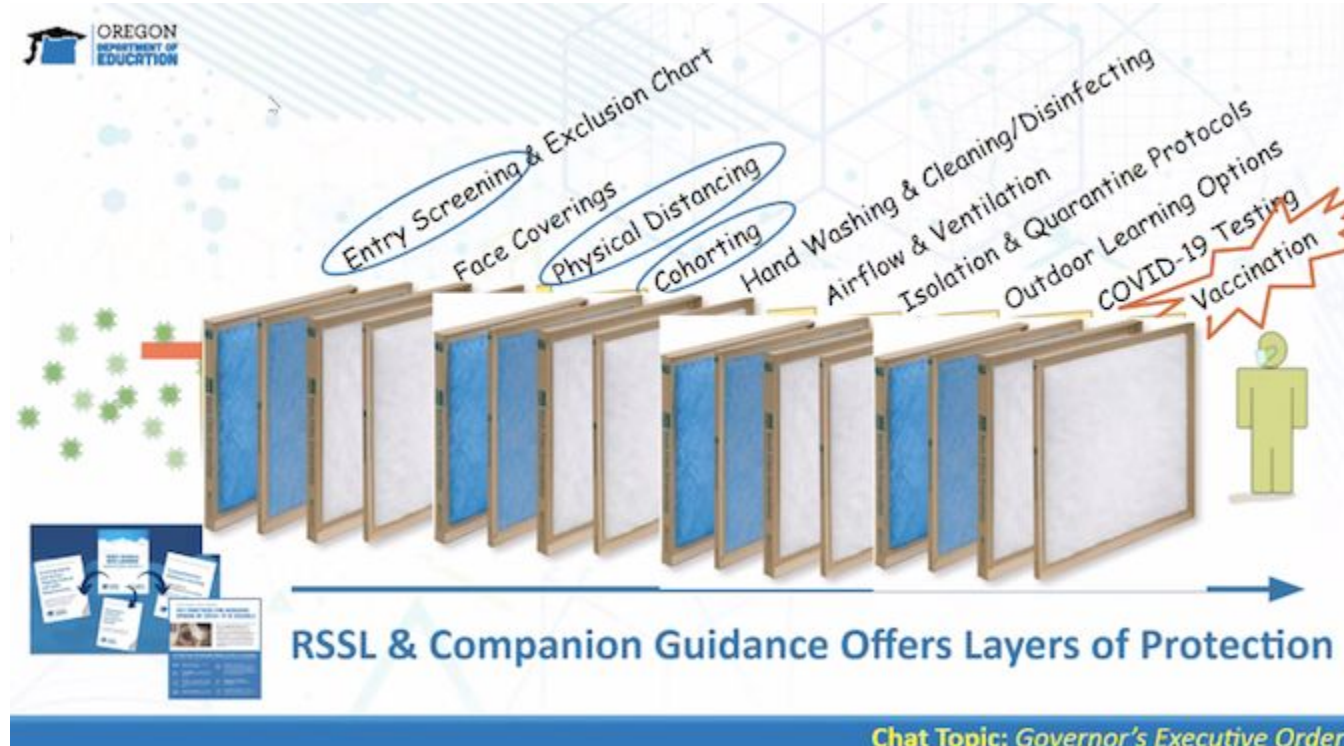


- We know the last year has had it's challenges for everyone and want CMS to feel safe and welcoming!

Cleaning Procedures

- All high touch areas will be cleaned and disinfected between cohorts, as well as at the end of the day.
 - Classroom desks, door knobs, pencil sharpeners, etc. will be cleaned and disinfected between cohorts and at the end of the day.
 - Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized at least twice daily.
 - Hallways will be cleaned and disinfected daily.
- Sharing of supplies will be limited, and supplies will be cleaned between students.

Care Room

- If a student exhibits the following symptoms, we will walk the student to the Care Room (Room 211) for a screening and to call home:
 - Fever of 100.4 or higher
 - Chills
 - A new cough that has not been diagnosed or cleared by a healthcare provider
 - Unexplained shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Vomiting
 - Diarrhea
 - Undiagnosed rash or sores
