We are pleased to inform you that Centennial School District **has been approved for CEP for the 2022-23 School Year.** This will be available to ALL schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs.

What does this mean for you and your children attending the school(s) identified below?

Great news for you and your students! Again, this year, all enrolled students of:

Butler Creek, Pleasant Valley, Powell Butte, Patrick Lynch, Parklane and Meadows Elementary, Centennial and Harold Oliver Middle & Centennial High Schools

are eligible to receive one healthy breakfast and one nutritious lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2021-22 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay or apply.

You DO NOT have to fill out any applications. All enrolled students are eligible.

Milk alone is an al carte item for those choosing to bring their own lunch, and costs \$.50. We suggest utilizing our companion meal, consisting of a fruit, a vegetable and a milk- this meal will be considered a “no charge” meal to accompany your child’s sack meal from home, if you choose.
