

# How To Log Into a Centennial Chromebook at Home

**Step 1:** Open the lid of the Chromebook

**Step 2:** The Chromebook should power on when the lid is opened. If it doesn't make sure that the device is plugged into power and charged.

**Step 3:** Choose your network (it will say network not available). You must connect to your home Wi-Fi connection and enter the password for that connection.

**Step 4:** Once the Chromebook is connected to your home Wi-Fi, your student will need to log into the device. Student login usernames use the student's first name, first letter of last name, and the 4-digit graduation year. For example: Student named Jane Doe who graduates in 2025 would have the username:

[janed2025@s.csd28j.org](mailto:janed2025@s.csd28j.org)

Password for grades K-8 is your child's ID number (same as lunch number). High school students set their own password.

**NOTE:** If your student does not know either their username or their student ID number, you will need to contact your child's teacher directly to obtain that information.

Once logged into the Chromebook, your child can access online resources by navigating to the Clever Portal or by clicking on the various app icons on the Chromebook desktop.
